

ORDINANCE NO. 144

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 124 2002 BUDGET, PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF A BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF BETHEL HEIGHTS, ARKANSAS;

WHEREAS, The City of Bethel Heights, Arkansas has previously enacted Ordinance No. 124, NOW THEREFORE, Be it ordained by the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Bethel Heights, Arkansas.


Section 1: From and after the effective date of this ordinance, Ordinance No. 124 shall be amended to accept the changes in the 2002 budget made at the following City Council meetings: January 15<sup>th</sup> - \$10,500.00 was appropriated for remaining building expenses for the Fire Department. February 19<sup>th</sup> - \$9,721.17 was appropriated towards the purchase of a police car. March 26<sup>th</sup> - \$20,000.00 was appropriated for installation of the step system for the fire department. September 17<sup>th</sup> - increased the budget for City Attorney by \$1,000.00 and the City Prosecutor by \$200.00 for the remainder of the year. November 19<sup>th</sup> - \$38,000.00 was appropriated for sewer engineering cost.

Section 2: December 17<sup>th</sup> - \$1,489.22 was appropriated for 2002 salary incentive for the four full time employees and two part time employees in the general fund as approved by the City Council, and \$ 50,000.00 was appropriated for the purchase of the Ginger Williams property to pay the closing cost and the remainder for down payment on the cost of the property.


