

ORDINANCE NO. 331

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 321, 2014 BUDGET, PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF A BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF BETHEL HEIGHTS, ARKANSAS;

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel Heights, Arkansas has previously enacted Ordinance No. 321,

NOW THEREFORE, Be it ordained by the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Bethel Heights, Arkansas.

Section 1: From and after the effective date of this ordinance, Ordinance No. 321 shall be amended to accept the changes in the 2014 budgets as attached herein and appropriations made at the following City Council meetings: **January 21<sup>st</sup> appropriated \$15,511.57 for the street lights at the Apple Meadows Subdivision, February 24<sup>th</sup> appropriated \$30,369.94 for overtime hours not paid to Chief Hart, March 18<sup>th</sup> appropriated \$30,031.75 for overtime hours not paid to Officer Yost, April 15<sup>th</sup> appropriated \$2,400 for the widening project at Highway 264, June 17<sup>th</sup> appropriated \$216,510.31 for repairs at Apple Blossom Avenue and Apple Meadows, June 17<sup>th</sup> appropriated \$34,000.13 for the street lights at Hathorn Drive, Munroe Drive, and Moody Avenue, June 17<sup>th</sup> appropriated \$7,652.63 for hours not paid to Officer Fenton, September 16<sup>th</sup> appropriated \$37,580.32 for the overtime hours not paid to Officer Randy Johnson, and hours not paid to Officers Grant Hall and Zack Williams, September 16<sup>th</sup> appropriated \$20,000 for the purchase of a mini excavator, and November 13<sup>th</sup> appropriated \$24,743.87 for the overtime hours not paid to Drew Deason and hours not paid to Officer Randy Rogers.**

THEREFORE, an emergency does hereby exist to amend the 2014 budget and this ordinance being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety and shall be in full force from and after the passage and approval.
