ORDINANCE NO. 52

AN ORDINANCE BANNING THE DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE INCORPORATED TOWN OF BETHEL HEIGHTS, ARKANSAS, AND FOR DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Incorporated Town of Bethel Heights, Arkansas, has found that it is in the best interests of the Town of Bethel Heights, Arkansas, and of its inhabitants that the discharge of firearms within the Corporate limits should be banned because of the danger to inhabitants thereof, and that numerous complaints have been received by the Chief of Police with regard to discharge of said firearms;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE INCORPORATED TOWN OF BETHEL HEIGHTS, ARKANSAS;

SECTION 1: Definitions of firearms/weapons: Firearms and or weapons shall be used interchangeably throughout this Ordinance and, shall mean the same thing. Firearms/weapons shall be any instrument intended for the discharge of projectiles, whether center-fire weapons or rimfire weapons, including but not limited to shotguns, rifles and handguns.

SECTION 2: From and after the effective date of this Ordinance, it shall be unlawful to discharge weapons or firearms within the corporate limits of the Incorporated Town of Bethel Heights, Arkansas, whether on private property or public property.

SECTION 3: Private land owners within the Incorporated Town of Bethel Heights, Arkansas, shall be authorized to permit discharge of said firearms on their private property by hunters or other persons as long as express written permission is granted to the hunters and it is within a State recognized hunting season as defined under the terms of the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission Rules and Regulations.

SECTION 4: Private land owners within the Incorporated Town of Bethel Heights, Arkansas, shall be authorized to discharge firearms on their private property. "Sighting in and target practice" shall be allowed on private property with the expressed permission and supervision of the land owner.

SECTION 5: Each time a violation of this Ordinance continues shall be deemed a separate offense and punished accordingly.

SECTION 6: PENALTIES: Any individual person, Firm, Corporation, Business or Organization which violates any provision of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and may be punished by a fine of not less than Two Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) and not more than Five Hundred Dollars per violation, plus Court costs. Additionally the Judge may sentence said violator to a term of not less than one (1) day in jail and not more than ten (10) days in the Benton County Jail.


SECTION 7: SEVERABILITY. If any section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by a decision of any Court, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the Ordinance.

SECTION 8: REPEALING CLAUSE. All provisions or parts of the Ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are herein repealed.

SECTION 9: That this Ordinance shall not affect the right of any certified Law Enforcement Officer, Probation Officer, Parole Officer or any other duly approved Court Officials from carrying or discharging firearms within the Corporate limits.

SECTION 10: That due to the continuing discharge of firearms by hunters within the Corporate limits of the Town of Bethel Heights and the danger to citizens therein, this Ordinance is necessary to preserve the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the Citizens and because of such an emergency is declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and after the time of its passage and approval.

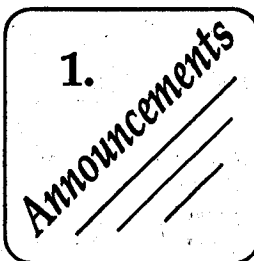
