

ORDINANCE NO. 119

AN ORDINANCE REPLACING ORDINANCE NO. 74, AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE COLLECTION OF WARRANT SERVICE FEES FOR THE BETHEL HEIGHTS POLICE DEPARTMENT, CREATING A WARRANTS FEE FUND, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

That the Town of Bethel Heights, Arkansas, has determined that additional costs are incurred by the Town as a result of having to serve warrants from the city court, and

WHEREAS, It is necessary to raise the court cost in order to help defray the necessary expenses of serving warrants.


NOW THEREFORE, Be it ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Bethel Heights, Arkansas,

SECTION 1: Warrant Service Fees: For each warrant of the City Court of Bethel Heights, Arkansas, served on a Defendant appearing before said Court, there shall be collected from each such Defendant upon each plea of guilty, nolo contendere, forfeiture of bond or determination of guilt for misdemeanors or traffic violations in the City Court the sum according to State Law, which sum shall be placed in a separate fund called Warrants Fee Fund to be used by the Town to defray the expenses of the service of warrants issued by the City Court of Bethel Heights, Arkansas.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Bethel Heights, Arkansas and an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage. Further that the requirement for three separate readings of the ordinance is hereby waived.
