

ORDINANCE NO. 124

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 116, PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF A BUDGET FOR THE INCORPORATED TOWN OF BETHEL HEIGHTS, ARKANSAS.

WHEREAS, the town of Bethel Heights, Arkansas has previously enacted Ordinance No. 116, NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Mayor and the Town Council of the Incorporated Town of Bethel Heights, Arkansas.

SECTION 1: From and after the effective date of this ordinance, Ordinance No. 116 shall be amended to accept the changes in the 2001 budget made at the following Town Council meetings. March 27th \$13,026.00 was appropriated for the new patrol car, August 21st \$360,000.00 was appropriated for construction of the Fire Station.

December 18th \$1,500.00 was moved to the Fire Department and \$1,500.00 to Supplies from Dues and L&P in the general fund. In the Police Department \$3,000.00 was moved to Phones, Tickets, & Misc. from Communications.

December 18th \$1,536.21 was appropriated for 2001 salary incentive for the four full-time employees and two-part time employees in the general fund as approved by the Town Council.

THEREFORE, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.
