

ORDINANCE NO. 171

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EMPLOYMENT OF A BUILDING INSPECTOR/CODE ENFORCEMENT OFFICER FOR THE CITY OF BETHEL HEIGHTS, ARKANSAS AND AMENDING THE 2004 BUDGET TO INCLUDE THE SALARY OF THE BUILDING INSPECTOR

WHEREAS, The City Council of Bethel Heights, Arkansas has determined that it is necessary to fill the position of Building Inspector/Code Enforcement Officer for the City of Bethel Heights, Arkansas with personnel employed by the City, and

WHEREAS, The City Council of Bethel Heights, Arkansas has concluded that in order to find someone who meets the qualifications and requirements of the position of Building Inspector/Code Enforcement Officer the City must open the position up to include those who may also hold other positions and/or be employed by the City, and

WHEREAS, The City Council of Bethel Heights, Arkansas takes this action of authorizing, by ordinance, the employment of one whom may also hold other positions and/or be employed by the City in order to comply with Section § 14-42-107 of the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF BETHEL HEIGHTS, ARKANSAS:

Section 1. That the Mayor of Bethel Heights, Arkansas is hereby authorized to fill the position of Building Inspector/Code Enforcement Officer with a qualified individual, which individual may be one who holds another position and/or is employed by the City.

Section 2. Compensation. That the budget for 2004 is amended to include the compensation for the position of Building Inspector/Code Enforcement Officer in the General Fund for expenditure from that fund toward such compensation.

Section 3. Conflict. Therefore that any ordinance or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of that conflict.


Section 4. Emergency Clause. Therefore that an emergency does hereby exist in order to provide building inspections and code enforcement for the City of Bethel Heights and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the passage and approval.
