ORDINANCE NO. 25

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE PARKING OF HEAVY TRUCKS, TRAILERS, AND INOPERATIVE VEHICLES ON THE STREETS OR ROAD RIGHT-OF-WAYS IN THE TOWN OF BETHEL HEIGHTS, ARKANSAS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Bethel Heights, Arkansas has found that it is in the best interest of the Town of Bethel Heights, Arkansas, and of its inhabitants that the parking of heavy trucks, trailers, and inoperative vehicles on the street or road right-of-ways within the Town of Bethel Heights, Arkansas, be prohibited.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Town Council of the Town of Bethel Heights, Arkansas:

SECTION-1: It shall be unlawful for any person to park, abandon, stand, or in any other manner leave unattended any tractor truck, detachable trailer more than fifteen (15) feet in length, inoperative or abandoned vehicle of any nature, or any other vehicle in excess of one-half ton in weight, upon the streets or road right-of-ways within the Town of Bethel Heights, Arkansas.

SECTION 2: The violation of this Ordinance shall constitute a violation and shall be punishable by a fine of not less than ten (\$10.00) dollars nor more than One Hundred (\$100.00) dollars. For the purposes of this Ordinance each day of non-compliance with this Ordinance shall constitute a separate violation.

SECTION 3: The Town Council hereby finds that the public has been and will be injured through inordinate wear and tear upon the streets and road right-of-ways of the Town, and that this Ordinance is necessary for the public health and safety, and an emergency is hereby declared to exist. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval, passage and publication.
