ORDINANCE NO. 41

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING BETHEL HEIGHTS' ORDINANCE NO. FOR ESTABLISHING MINIMUM SPECIFICATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS RELATING TO THE CONSTRUCTION, IMPROVEMENTS AND REPAIR OF STREETS IN THE TOWN OF BETHEL HEIGHTS, ARKANSAS AND FOR DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Bethel Heights, Arkansas, has on or about the 13th day of January, 1986, passed an Ordinance establishing minimum construction requirements for streets within the corporate limits of the Town of Bethel Heights, Arkansas; and

WHEREAS, said Ordinance needs to be amended in one particular respect in order to meet construction requirements;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Bethel Heights, Arkansas:

 24 , enacted on January 13, That Ordinance No. SECTION 1: 1986, shall be amended as follows:

Section 6: All new private driveways connected to a city street shall have installed on their own an 18-inch minimum drainage tile with a minimum length of 20 feet, except that on Morris Lane in the Town of Bethel Heights, the requirement shall be reduced to a 15-inch minimum drainage tile with a minimum length of 20 feet. landowners are required to keep the tile installed across their private drives open and free of obstruction. person who fills in a ditch with dirt or gravel to gain access to a city street or road shall be subject to a fine of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for each offense, and each day shall constitute a new offense.

24 SECTION 2: That Ordinance No. as previously passed by the Town Council on January 13, 1986, is hereby re-adopted in full with the above amendment incorporated into it and no other changes.

SECTION 3: The Town Council has found that the amendment to the drainage tile requirement in Section 6 along Morris Lane only is a necessary requirement for the construction of the road in that area, and that this Ordinance is necessary for the public health and safety, and an emergency is hereby declared to exist due to the fact that construction is now progressing along said This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval, passage, and publication.
